Dr. Bruce Love has been researching and publishing on Maya culture for more than 30 years and brings his expertise to the topic of Maya predictions and its calendar. The Maya had a number of calendar systems, some of which have been lost over time while others remain vibrant among today's indigenous groups. Dr. Love will show examples from classic Maya monuments as well as the 17th century Books of Chilam Balam, and there will be audience participation in learning how to read the dates found among the ancient hieroglyphs. By the end of the evening we will be closer to separating the truth from the fiction about Dec. 21, 2012.
